The Committee recommends the adoption of the following resolution:

- Whereas, There is a gap between Middle School members and High School members in CDE involvement.
- Whereas, There are safety concerns with Middle School members participating on teams such as Farm Powers, Ag Mech, Ect.
- Whereas, Some agricultural careers do not have CDE teams
- Whereas, Winter CDE teams do not receive the recognition they deserve
- Whereas, Winter CDE's have less teams compete compared to spring CDE teams

Therefore, be it

- Resolved, Middle School FFA members should participate on CDE teams; specifically the ones that are low in team participation.
- Resolved, Middle school members should go through safety training to help prevent injury.
- Resolved, CDE teams such as beekeeping, ag debate, coding, and farrier judging should be offered.
- Resolved, Winter CDE teams should get recognized at the annual state convention, and have State Officers present awards during the winter state finals awards ceremony.
- Resolved, Middle School members should participate in winter CDE's, and the new CDE teams mentioned above should be held during the winter.
