The Program of Activities Committee is to develop recommendations related to various areas of the California FFA Association's Program of Activities.

#### ***Expansion of SAE Opportunities - Committee 2.2***

*The purpose of the Committee on the expansion of SAE Opportunities is to assess the current SAE opportunities and suggest new SAE educational recognition opportunities. These opportunities include, but are not limited to, New Proficiency Areas and evaluating State Degree Requirements.*

*The Committee recommends the adoption of the following resolution:*

- Whereas, there is a lack of media promoting proficiency and STAR Awards to chapters statewide
- Whereas, students often do not know what proficiency or STAR Awards they are eligible for and often times don't apply as a result
- Whereas, new teachers may not have the experience to assist students in filling out award areas
- Whereas, the current state degree conversion ratio is equivalent to 1 hour being \$1 in value and is unfair for students who pursue unpaid projects
- Whereas, not all California FFA Members have equitable resources in social media and technology.
- Whereas, there are limited resources promoting SAE For All and incorporating this program could be promising to our state association.

*Therefore, be it*

- Resolved, that California FFA put into place an educational video that highlights proficiency and STAR awards as part of the curriculum in the classroom
- Resolved, California FFA create a form about SAEs so that students can be led to proficiency and STAR awards they qualify for

- Resolved, that new Ag teachers' be provided with resources and guides at the annual CATA meeting that demonstrates the procedures behind applying for award areas
- Resolved, the State Degree ratio for unpaid hours reflect 1 hour being equal \$2 .
- Resolved, California FFA utilize both social media and paper promotional materials to inform all members of SAE opportunities.
- Resolved, that the state should create a database for teachers to use in order to promote SAE for All in our association.
