

# National Invitational FFA Quiz Contest Rules

### **\* Contest Rules \***

1. **ALL** FFA chapters are invited for the 2019 contest! There is no state or chapter limit.
2. Teams may have 1 to 4 members; however, team scores will consist of the added scores of the three high scores from each team.
3. There will be **THREE** separate divisions. Jr. High FFA members must be currently enrolled in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade at the time of competing. Jr. Quiz members must be currently enrolled in 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> grade and Sr. quiz members must be currently enrolled in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade at the time of competition. A student may compete in a higher level (example: an 8<sup>th</sup> grader may move up to the Jr. Division) only if that student is needed to make a team complete in the higher division (example: you have 2-9<sup>th</sup> graders and need an 8<sup>th</sup> grader to complete the team). NO student may compete in a lower division (example: a 9<sup>th</sup> grader MAY NOT compete in the Jr. High Division). No student may participate if they have graduated from high school. A student may only compete on one team.
4. All team members must have paid state and national dues.
5. Official FFA dress is required for all contestants.
6. Jr. and Sr. contests will consist of 100 multiple choice questions. The Junior High Exam will be 50 questions that are more age appropriate. Questions will come from all sections of the **most current** Official FFA manual (online version). Copies of the manual can be purchased from the National FFA Organization or downloaded free from the national FFA website.
7. The contest will begin at 5:00 pm at location to be determined.
8. All team members must take the test at the same time. In case of delayed arrivals; advisors may request a later starting time by contacting David Frazier at (325) 660-4663. This must be done prior to the 5:00 pm start time. Teams that arrive after 6:30 pm will be scored separately and **WILL NOT** be considered for team or individual awards.
9. In case of a tie, the team with the highest point individual will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie with high point individuals on both team, the second, then third, then fourth high point individuals will be used to determine winner. If these efforts cannot determine a winner, both teams will be declared Co-winners.

10. Ties for high point individuals will be broken based on whose team was the higher ranking team. If both individual are from the same team, a coin toss will determine who will be recognized.
11. Entry fees will be \$40.00 per team and **should be paid at check-in**. Please make checks payable to: **National Quiz Contest – David Frazier**.
12. Scantrons will be provided for each team member.
13. Registration will begin at 4:30 pm at contest location.
14. A # 2 leaded pencil will be required for each contestant.
15. There is NO limit to the number of teams a chapter may enter
16. All teams are encouraged to enter the contest by October 20, 2019 at [www.judgingcard.com](http://www.judgingcard.com) or by sending intent to compete to [frazier@tarleton.edu](mailto:frazier@tarleton.edu); however, **teams may be registered at the contest site prior to the start of the event**. The early registration helps us have an idea of the number of exams to make. There will be NO late entry fee.
17. This contest is not sanctioned or run by the National FFA Organization.
