# Call to Order

# Review of Minutes

The minutes of the 1984 Spring Executive Committee Meeting were approved as read.

## National FFA Business

Mr. Jerry Davis explained that the National Organization has not yet compiled any constitutional ammendments for the National Convention.

### National Convention Trip

Mr. Tom Munter reported that about 150 students, advisors, and parents have made reservations for the National Convention trip.

### Santa Fe Railroad Merit Award

Mr. Davis explained that each Regional President and State Officer will receive a special award of \$200.00 to help with the cost of the National Convention trip. Mr. Davis noted that all Regional Presidents and State Officers will be obligated to attend a special banquet at the National Convention which is being hosted by Santa Fe for the Merit Award recipients.

Motion: John Pavletich moved to "recommend to the State Staff that, if funds are available, the Mid-Winter Executive Committee Meeting include all Regional Officers and for that meeting to be held in the month of January in a central statewide location such as Fresno." Carolyn Coleman seconded the motion. Debate followed.

Amendment: Carri Estes moved to ammend the motion by adding, "Fall Executive Committee Meeting minutes and the Winter agenda shall be sent out to all Regional Officers approximately two weeks prior to the meeting." Michael Gayaldo seconded the amendment. Debate followed.

Vote: The amendment and the main motion each passed unanimously.
