

STATE FFA ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES

December 12, 1991

The State FFA Advisory Committee met Thursday, December 12, 1991 at the California State Grange Headquarters in Sacramento. Present were Wayne Pitzler (Chairman and Southern Region rep.), Bob Kuntz (South Coast Region rep), George Green (Superior Region rep), Mark Anglin (Central Region rep), and Tom Munter (ex-officio). The absent representatives did send their survey results such that information was available from all regions relative to the major agenda items.

The primary business of the meeting was to review the results of the surveys conducted at Fall Regional CATA meetings and determine if any recommendations were appropriate.

Through discussion committee members made the following suggestions for consideration:

- A. That the Assistant State Advisor work with the State FFA officers next summer to create an "Opening of the Year" video to be available to schools on a "pay as you go" basis.
- B. That State Leadership Conference planning consider including an information booth and message center next May.
- C. That the Assistant State Advisor prepare a brief sheet of points to evaluate at the State Leadership Conference which Advisory Committee members in attendance can use to assist in evaluating the activity.
