MINUTES

Call To Order

Discussion Regarding State Degree Requirements

Thomas/Longacre moved/seconded that the State President appoint a committee of three or four people to study the issue of state degree requirements, develop specific criteria for minimum qualifications for election to the degree, and report its recommendations on this topic at the Spring State Executive Committee Meeting. Motion passed by voice vote. President Andrus appointed the following committee: Jenny Thomas (Chair), Robin Perez, Ryan Mendoza, and Kevin White.

The meeting recessed at 5 p.m.

The meeting was reconvened by President Andrus at 8 a.m. on Thursday, February 21, 1991.

Kevin White explained the changes proposed to the State Program of Work. They are:

- 1. Division I, Objective 3b: Change "7" to "6"
- 2. Division II, Objective 5a: Delete
- Division IV, Add Objective 14: Every three years a chapter will receive a state officer visitation providing presentations promoting the opportunities in the FFA.

<u>Richards/White</u> moved/seconded that the State Executive Committee recommend a "Do Pass" vote on these changes. Motion <u>passed</u> by voice vote.

Chapter Status

Mr. Munter updated the Committee on chapter charter activity since its last meeting.

<u>Richards/Sedlander</u> moved/seconded to approve the action of dropping the charters for Bakersfield-East, North San Juan-Pliocene Ridge, and Hemet Junior High. Motion <u>passed</u> by voice vote.

<u>Longacre/Mendoza</u> moved/seconded to approve the action of reinstating the charter for Clarksburg-Delta. Motion <u>passed</u> by voice vote.
