Student Resources for AET – Subcommittee 2.6

The purpose of the Committee on Resources for AET is to suggest the type of resources students would find useful in operating AET. These ideas include, but are not limited to resources for chapter management, SAE resources, Application resources, etc.

The subcommittees were chaired by: Taryn Wright, Hollister- San Benito/ Lexi Vanella, Durham/ Macie McPeak, Ripon

The Committee recommends the adoption of the following resolution:

- Whereas, the AET does not have a very user-friendly interface on both the app and website, which may lead to confusion and a deficit in participation and overall use by students.
- Whereas, the AET does not provide enough notification of upcoming events, due dates, and opportunities available to members.
- Whereas, there is a lack of information and integration of available applications on the AET.
- Whereas, there is no social media aspect allotted to the AET.

Therefore, be it

- Resolved, there should be an online or in-person orientation, which all or some of the chapter officers attend, that gives an introductory understanding to the AET and gives insight as to how it can be used and integrated into their chapters.
- Resolved, new videos should be added for both student and teacher instruction on frequently asked questions.
- Resolved, an influx of notifications should be added to the online and mobile app. These can be linked to the SAE and calendar portions of the AET and give frequent updates of useful information and remind the members to log their hours on a daily and/or weekly basis.
- Resolved, better application integration in the calendar and a new tab labeled "Applications" should be added to the AET which houses application opportunities for scholarships, leadership conferences and positions, etc.
- Resolved, if added, a social media portion of the AET will give students and chapters an incentive to share their own projects and other chapter events with other students and chapters which will allow

for a surge of influential ideas and creativity across all users. Furthermore, it will give members a new way to connect with those who share similar interests.
