Golden 1

- Pick up at Golden 1 – they have a place set for us

- Where downtown and the fees
 - Can we purchase in advance? They should have answers on Thursday

Buses:

- Currently, reached out and asked teachers who need buses
- We still have people that are stating that they need a bus
- 150 from Cal Expo
- 150 Natomas
- 300 students out of 5300
 - If we don't use the money there, we can use it to offset COVID
- Don't know if we can even get buses, such a short notice
- Do we have a preference or recommendation on what we can do?

COVID

- Golden 1 : The day you get tested on Friday, it's good from Friday & Saturday
 - Saturday, good for Saturday and Sunday
- Convention Center was saying 48 hours
- The number of nurses to test students and teachers are crazy number

- Next step is to reach out to the County of Health to see if they can change the guidelines for us
- Might still need to test every other day.
- Issue – we have a Monday morning session – so people would need to get tested early Monday morning.
- Students are not getting tested to go to school – this is an extracurricular activity, not extra curricular
- Golden 1 stated that they are following the county requirements, so if the county changes, then Golden 1 will adhere to those.
- If you are vaccinated – you have to wear a mask through the vaccine check and then you can remove them.
 - o If they are not vaccinated, it is recommended to wear a mask, but we are not mandating it
- We are not going to pass the cost to the students (went from \$35 per person to \$15)
- They will accept teachers who are certified
 - o Needs to have the signature of the person who is certified and the name of the student that is negative
 - o Some school districts will certify them for free
 - o Needs to print individual records – not a mass list of everyone that is negative

Bags
