frequently asked questions

Q: Do I have to do an interview?

A: Yes, ALL FIRST YEAR applicants have to do a 10-minute Zoom interview with Jasmine Standridge. Standridge will send out Sign-Up Genius link to pick an interview time AFTER May 29 once all applicants have submitted an application.

Q: How many teams are there?

A: There are 5 (five) teams! Central, Coastal, Northern, San Joaquin, and Southern.

Q: Will I be placed on the team closest to my college?

A: Not always the case. Some facilitators get chosen for teams based on team needs / college applicant pool / school schedule. The goal is to get you as close to your school as possible and Standridge spends DAYS agonizing over team and school schedules to benefit students and facilitators!

Q: Can I request a team?

A: You can request a team if your heart desires, no promises can be made but an idea of where you're at in your thought process / desires is helpful!

Q: Can I miss a day of training?

A: The training dates are required, and unfortunately not able to be moved or changed unless a great circumstance is presented.
